COMMITTEE REPORTS

Treasurer's Report (Karen Yoshihara)

Bank Balance 4/23/23 : \$ 8,823.61

Karen reviewed the current budget and reported that we are on track as projected. The 50/50 raffle sales help to provide some cushion on unexpected costs. Marina and Mae will continue heading up the sales at the GM's.

Tournament Report (Letty Burks)

The H2H was rescheduled to July 20 at San Juan (Anaheim Hills/Fallbrook/Arrowwood), with the same format. Signups begin in June and there are 68 slots available starting at 8:30, shotgun start. The restaurant has been alerted to the event and the size of the field. Member cooperation will be needed to help the flow of drink and food orders. Those in first should order immediately and finish their cards after ordering. Robin Fong is the coordinator of this event.

The Club Championship starts on June 1. Members were reminded of the eligibility requirements. Claire Fisher and Linda Healion will be handling this event. There is a regular and senior division, flighted.
